2. Treasurers Report

3. Repairs & Improvements – Chris McDermott

Outside Store and Toilet

Electrical work to the interior of the store/toilet should now be complete along with the double doors to the fuel tank. Sanitary ware to be delivered and installation complete by the end of this week

Some lights have been replaced in the hall so they all now match.

4. Parish Council

Addition of steps from pavement - Steve reported that the steps from the new development to the village hall car park would be paid for by the Parish Council together with a barrier next to the road. The path to the outside toilet would have wheel chair access with a hand rail on playground side. Fencing around the playground would have a saloon style gate. Rospa had advised on playground improvements – this was also to be paid for by the Parish Council.

The Jubilee Path is to be repaired/replaced during first week of October – Parish Council The Parish Council have reduced the tree height around bowling green and maintenance will be ongoing. Lap tops have been provided to St Peters School.
