

ADDERLEY PARISH COUNCIL

Adderley Parish Council met on Wednesday 2nd September 2015 at Adderley Village Hall. All Councillors less Cllr's Roche & Cornwall were in attendance including Cllr Paul Wynn, the Unitary Authority Cllr and they discussed the following matters:

The Parish Council had continued to receive a number of Neighbourhood Watch Bulletins and these had been passed on to Parishioners. The Council is still pursuing an expansion of the scheme within Adderley. All the warnings are now being published on the Village Web Site (adderleyparish.co.uk) and on the Village Face Book page and also via the Village e-mail system.

It was noted that again there was no Police Force information/report supplied.

The Clerk was again asked to report the many potholes that are appearing on the main road from the Church towards Market Drayton and also in the area of the school. It was noted that a number of these were repairs that are "breaking-down". It was further noted that the "Slow" markings had now been painted on the Norton in Hales road but needed to be "washed" due to the amount of mud that had been left on them by local farm contractors that was becoming a hazard to drivers..

It had been noted that a "no through road" sign had now been fitted on Rectory Lane on the Norton Lane side of the bridge.

The latest Highways report on repairs was discussed and the Clerk was asked to confirm with Highways that the repairs due to Norton Lane would still be going ahead.

It was confirmed that the quote supplied for the renovation of the Jubilee Path had been accepted by the Councillors (after note: work is now underway by the contractor).

It was further noted that the new Village Hall store was progressing well. But that the "Playground" was getting worse. Cllr Paterson agreed to hold a site visit with the preferred contractor and to have them start the work to renovate the "Play area" and fencing as soon as possible; he also agreed to get three quotes for the fitting of new steps from the road by the new pathway down into the Hall carpark.

The Market Drayton Neighbourhood Plan was discussed as Market Drayton Town intends to include part of the parish within its plan. This was frowned upon by the Cllrs who agreed they would attend the next meeting to ensure the Parish was not disadvantaged by it.

The defibrillator and cabinet had now been received along with a number of CPR training "dolls" and plans were agreed for village training and the installation of the cabinet on the village Hall wall.

The council had received a "Funding" request from St Peters Church for the repair and changes to the Cemetery entrance to allow wheelchair access at a cost of £385. This was agreed by all and the Clerk was asked to inform the Vicar of this.

The Funding request from the Friends of Adderley School was confirmed and an invoice received and paid for three laptop computers and software.

It was reported that the Bowls Club hedge cutting had now been completed to their satisfaction.

There being no further business the meeting was closed.

The next meeting will be on 14th October 2015 at Adderley Village Hall starting at 7.30pm.
