- By arrangement with the local Co-ordinators, NHW schemes may provide holiday cover when member residents are away from home. This is not a 24hr. security service but neighbour members looking out for other neighbour's welfare.
- Discounts for Registered Members attending our Women's Self-Assertion/ Self-Defence Classes.
- **Membership Fees are used to provide**
 - Association officers attend local NHW scheme meetings to discuss and explain joint Crime Prevention and Home Security measures, plus national and regional conferences.
 - Administrative back-up - Website and Email Crime Reports, Newsletters, Minutes of Meetings and their circulation/distribution to Co-ordinators, literature where not already available or where existing leaflets do not meet local requirements.

ALL Registered Members have a say in the running of their Association, usually via their local Co-ordinator who attends the quarterly Co-ordinators Meeting where NHW matters are discussed and action decided upon. ALL Registered Members have a vote on the annual election of Association Officers.

Personal Data Handling Statement

1. North Shropshire Neighbourhood & Farm Watch (NHW) Association (hereinafter referred to as the Association) holds the personal data of registered members of the Association on a computer database.

This personal data consists of your Name, Address, Telephone and/or Fax numbers and Email addresses, where given.

2. The personal data held by the Association will be used for:

- Administration and communication purposes within the Association;
- Preventing and detecting crime; and
- Giving assistance to West Mercia Constabulary in accordance with the Association's policies and procedures.

3. The data may be passed to:

- West Mercia Constabulary for the purposes described in Item 2 above, within the terms of the Association's notification with the Office of the Information Commissioner.
- National Neighbourhood Watch Association, West Mercia Neighbourhood Association and/or West Midlands Region Neighbourhood Watch Association if it is legitimately permitted to hold personal data for the purposes of providing support to North Shropshire Neighbourhood & Farm Watch Association.

4. Once placed onto the database, the personal data can only be accessed by authorised users of the system. Computers are password protected and are situated in Association authorised premises.

5. The database is updated as and when inaccuracies are identified in the course of ongoing liaison.

6. Nothing in the Statement affects any local agreements where Scheme Co-ordinators or others have entered into agreements, which make their personal data more widely available.

7. Personal details will **not** be disclosed to any commercial organisation without prior consent of the individual concerned.

Protection of Personal Data
