HAVE YOUR SAY

Following public engagement and discussions, including the sharing of early design ideas last year, the Village Hall Committee is taking the opportunity to further assess the best future options for this valuable community asset. It is essential to ensure the hall serves the needs of Adderley both today and for many years to come.

Villagers are being asked to provide much-needed feedback on formal proposals for the future of the Village Hall and Bowling Pavilion. These venues exist for the entire community, and decisions regarding their management will be guided by the wishes of the community.

Current funding would only allow for limited refurbishment of the hall, such as a new roof and a modest rebuild of the pavilion. Further work would only be possible through grant funding, which may be limited. Any such funding would require an application process, which includes a formal consultation

Consultation is a key part of this process, and to ensure you have the opportunity to engage, the committee has set out a timeline.

APRIL

Collation of questionnaire responses and analysis of results. Announcement of results via social media and website.

MAY

Public Consultation event to engage with villagers.

JUNE

The Village Hall Committee will set out a business plan to deliver the outcomes of the consultation, share project aims, and outline the design and project timeline.
